Our Wee Community: *You may be wondering who Saints Alypius and Possidius are (see Feasts of the Week)? Alypius was a close friend of St Augustine and was baptised with him in Milan in 387. Possidius, who lived with Augustine in community, wrote a famous biography of him, the only eyewitness account we have. One day, Augustine overheard some bishops slandering someone at the table. He told them that unless they stopped, he would leave the room. Inscribed on the table were the words, 'Let those who like to slander the lives of the absent know that their own are not worthy of this table'. The same inscription (in Latin) is in the monastery dining room at San Gimignano.* Fr Paul
